

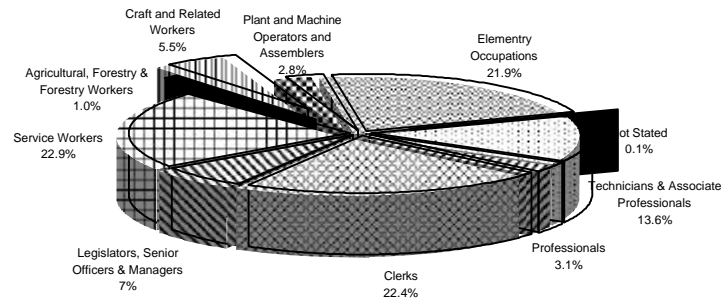

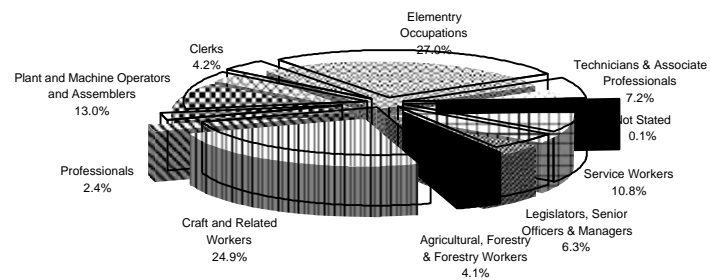

CHART 3: PERCENTAGE OF ECONOMICALLY ACTIVE MEN BY MAJOR OCCUPATIONAL GROUP 2000



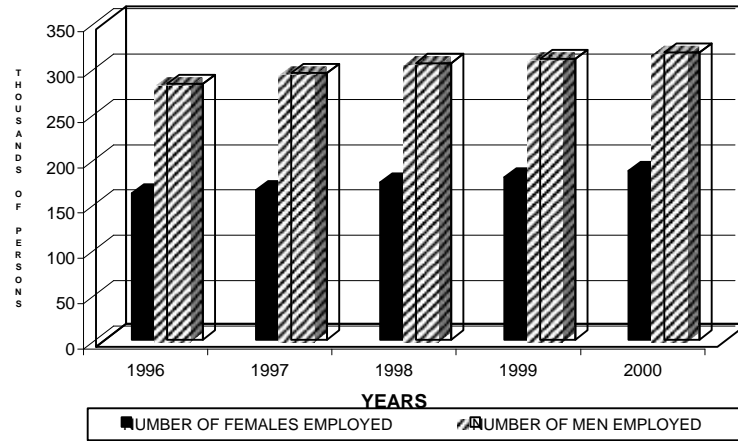
